Friends of the Richardson Public Library Announce Successful 2014 Spring Book Sale

Richardson, Texas, April 30, 2014 – The Friends of the Richardson Public Library (FOL) Spring Book Sale, held April 25-27, 2014, exceeded expectations and will allow the FOL to continue its high levels of contributions to the Library and its mission.

Walter King, book sale chair, reported that:

- 1,153 people attended the sale.
- Net sales and contributions totaled \$10,616.54.
- At least \$500 was sold in sponsorships, with another \$100 paid for the fall sale.
- Thirteen teen Library volunteers combined for more than 40 hours of community service during the Book Sale and Trash Bash, which took place April 26.

William J. 'Bill' McCalpin, President of the FOL, expressed his delight at the results: "Dozens of FOL volunteers spent hundreds of hours preparing and conducting this sale, and their efforts are an invaluable part of the estimated \$27,000 that the FOL is donating to the Richardson Public Library in fiscal year 2013-2014. We couldn't do it with our workers or the people in the community who come to our sales and make a point of finding homes for good books."
